KILLINGTON LIFT TICKETS & USER PROFILES

This season Killington Resort will be utilizing a personalized lift ticket system that allows guests to access all Killington products via their own personal RFID card. These new personal ID cards replace traditional paper lift tickets. For this reason, any member of the trip who is buying a Killington lift ticket, lessons or rentals will need to create their own user profile in advance, as outlined below, in order to obtain their ID card. If a skier already has a Killington lift-ticket (e.g. an IKON pass or Killington season pass) they do not need to create a user profile or sign the waiver.

The process for creating the user profile is straightforward and can be completed in less than five minutes. Upon signing up for the trip, and providing your email address, you will receive an email from VST with instructions and links to two forms:

Link 1: USER PROFILE (3 minutes) Each skier (or parent/guardian if under 18) must complete their Killington user profile with their contact information, and if applicable, rental or lesson information.

Link 2: LIABILITY WAIVER (1 minute) Each skier (or parent/guardian if under 18) must sign the waiver.

Any parent or guardian who has multiple skiers on the trip must complete a separate profile and waiver for each skier, however, the same email address and guardian info can be used for each profile.

In order to allow Killington time to print and deliver the personalized passes, each skier (or parent/guardian if under 18) must complete their profile setup **NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 16, 2024 AT 5PM.** The passes will then be printed and delivered to the hotel prior to the group's arrival.

If a skier does not create a user profile and sign the waiver by the above deadline, Killington will be unable to print the pass in time and that individual will then need to buy their own lift tickets via the ticket window or online at the retail rate.
